


# **Ideal settings for Blackboard Assessments**

Blackboard Learn has many options for how to customize assessments. To access settings for tests, assignments, and forms select Settings on the new assessment's page. The Settings panel opens. We will focus on this document about the most important settings. You can view all other details about Blackboard Assessment Settings in this <a href="link">link</a>.

#### **AVAILABILITY**

**Show or hide an assessment**. Students can't see the assessment until you choose to show it. You can create all your content ahead of time and choose what you want students to see based on your schedule. You can also set **Release conditions** based on <u>members</u>, <u>groups</u>, <u>date</u>, <u>time</u>, and <u>performance</u> on other items in the course gradebook.




Apply Assessment settings. Select the Settings icon to open the panel where you provide the details and information.



#### **Details & Information**


- 1. Set A Due Date and Time
- 2. You may check "Prohibit new attempts after due date" to prevent students from beginning a new attempt after the due date has passed.





# **Presentation Options**


You desire flexibility in question presentation. For example, you may select a one-questionat-a-time presentation, Prohibit backtracking and Randomized questions & answers.






### **Grading & Submissions**

Determine the number of attempts. You can let your students submit more than one attempt at a test. When you allow multiple attempts, you can also choose how the final grade is calculated.



#### Assessment grade


You can choose to post assessment grades automatically when the assignment is graded. The feature includes automatically and manually graded assignments, as well as tests with autograded question types. **Turn the setting off if you want to manually control grade publication.** 






# **Assessment Security**


Under this section you can configure time limit & align your assessment to the goals area, assign group assessment, and add plagiarism detection using (SafeAssign).





# Add a timer to your test

A time limit can keep students on track and focused on the test because they have a limited amount of time to submit. The test attempts are saved and submitted automatically when time is up.
