


Figure1: Graduate Job placement status of the graduates of the Bachelor of Science in Nursing program in the last three academic years

Figure1 illustrates graduate job placement status of BSN program graduates over the last three academic years. This table presents the current job status of graduates for the years 2022 to 2024, highlighting the number and percentage of full-time employment among graduates. Notably, a consistent majority of graduates have secured full-time positions, with percentages ranging from 72.73% in 2023 to 87.9% in 2024.
