- From the viewing menu, the college dean can select the screen “**Course offering**” can search and view the course offering in the department.

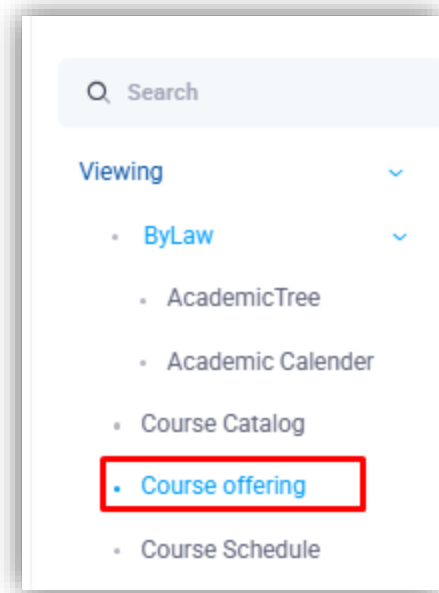


Figure 1 – Course offering

1-Search Filters

- Academic Year: Select the year for which course offerings should be displayed.
- Semester: Choose the semester to view courses offered during that period.
- College: Select the college providing the courses.
- Department: Filters results to courses offered by the chosen department.
- Scientific Degree: Filter by academic level (All, Undergraduate, Postgraduate).
- Course Code: Search for a specific course using its code.
- Course Level: Filter courses by their academic level or stage.
- Search: Applies selected filters to display matching courses.
- Reset: Clears all filter selections.

2-Search Results Table

- Course Code: Unique identifier for the course.
- Course Name: Official name of the course.
- CH (Credit Hours): Number of credit hours assigned.
- Online: Indicates whether the course is offered online.
- Min. # Stud.: Minimum number of students required.
- Co-Ordinator: Assigned course coordinator or a placeholder if not assigned.
