Course Description

Course Code: NUR504 Course Title: Advanced Health Assessment

Develop advanced knowledge and skills in conducting comprehensive health assessments for clients with different conditions. Apply various assessment techniques and communication skills to appraise clients' health status. Utilize critical thinking to identify clients' problems by analyzing findings of the health history, physical examination, and related diagnostic tests. Synthesize the health assessment findings for formulating priority nursing diagnoses and planning effective nursing care.

Course Code: NEPH501 Course Title: Nephrology Nursing, I

This course provides in-depth knowledge of anatomy and physiology of the kidney and urinary tract, emphasizing the assessment of kidney and urinary functions. Students will explore the pathophysiology, diagnostic measures and the multidisciplinary management of various kidney diseases emphasizing renal replacement therapy and kidney transplantation. The course focuses on the nephrology nurse's role in providing patient-centered care for various kidney diseases including acute kidney injury and end-stage kidney disease. Prior knowledge includes basic human anatomy and physiology.

Course Code: NEPH502 Course Title: Nephrology Nursing Practicum I

This course equips students with specialized clinical skills in the assessment and management of patients with various kidney diseases. The course focus on providing evidence-based nursing care for patients undergoing renal replacement therapy such as hemodialysis, peritoneal dialysis, and kidney transplantation. Throughout the clinical experience, students will demonstrate critical thinking and therapeutic communication skills with patients and healthcare team members in nephrology settings.

Course Code: NUR505 Course Title: Advanced Nursing Research and Evidence-Based Practice

Provide advanced knowledge of nursing research approaches, methodologies, ethics, and evidence-based Practice. Apply the research process in designing a systematic research plan in the field of nursing and critiquing different aspects of nursing research articles.

Course Code: NEPH503 Course Title: Nephrology Nursing II

This course equips students with advanced knowledge in managing patients with renal disorders. Key topics include urinary tract infection, kidney stones, voiding dysfunction, renal cancers as well as nutritional consideration, psychosocial and sexual health of patients with chronic kidney disease. By the end of the course, students will able to formulate holistic patient-centered nursing care for patients with different renal conditions using the nursing process and approach.

Course Code: NEPH504 Course Title: Nephrology Nursing Practicum II

This course enables students to apply the advanced theoretical knowledge and skills in the nursing care of patients with various kidney diseases, integrating evidence-based practice and the current clinical guidelines. Students will demonstrate competency in the delivery of specialized nursing care in complex nephrology care settings using a nursing process approach. The course also enables students to use the contemporary soft skills and advanced technology in the provision of nephrology nursing care within the ethical and professional standards.

Course Code: NEPH505 Course Title: Consolidated Practicum in Nephrology Nursing

This course provides students with opportunities to consolidate their advanced knowledge and clinical competencies in the care of patients with various kidney diseases. Students are expected to demonstrate proficiency in performing advanced health assessment using the clinical parameters and findings of the different diagnostic measures. Throughout this practicum course, students will independently plan and implement evidence-based nursing care using advanced technology and current clinical guidelines within the ethical and legal frameworks. Students will also utilize their clinical judgment, leadership and collaboration skills with patients and interdisciplinary healthcare teams at diverse nephrology care settings.
